

DRESS REGULATIONS

26.

26.1 In order to preserve the Club atmosphere, Members and their Guests must be neatly attired at all times.

Not Permitted – at any time

- Hats/ Caps
- Offensive or revealing clothing
- Torn or dirty clothing
- T-shirts with offensive motifs or unseemly language thereon
- Shorts considered revealing
- Bike pants
- Leisure wear that is transparent when stretched or has offensive design printing thereon

26.2 Doorpersons are authorised the right to refuse entry to any person who does not conform to these dress regulations.

26.3 The Club reserves the right to refuse entry if dress or tidiness does not conform to the Club's standards.

26.4 The final decision as to what is considered acceptable neat attire will be left with the manager on duty.

26.5 The Club reserves the right to refuse entry if dress or tidiness does not conform to the Club's standards

26.6. Other Regulations-

Duty Managers are authorised to refuse entry to the club or order out of the Club persons who are deemed to have

- Offensive body odour
- Offensive odours emanating from their clothing
